

Megan comes up with a new town logo

SCHOOLGIRL Megan Isaaks has designed the face of neighbourhood planning in Totnes.

The King Edward VI Community College pupil has produced the logo for the important planning process which will help form the future blueprint for development in and around Totnes.

The teenager - who also designed a new logo for the Totnes Show earlier this year - will be attending a Neighbourhood Plan open meeting due to go ahead at Totnes Civic Hall tomorrow when she will receive a thank you presentation from town mayor Cllr Jacoi

The Totnes Neighbourhood Plan was first unveiled at the town meeting in May.

The open meeting, which kicks off at 7.30pm, is aimed at community groups and residents who are being invited to turn up to hear how the plan process has progressed over the summer.

Totnes Town Council began working towards developing a Neighbourhood Plan for all or parts of Totnes in response to the Localism Act introduced in 2011.

With a Neighbourhood Plan, communities are able to establish general plan-

opment and use of land in a neighbourhood.

They will be able to say, for example, where new homes and offices should be built and what they should look like.

The Neighbourhood Plan will set a vision for the future.

It can be detailed, or general, depending on what local people want.

Said a town council spokesman: 'Information is now being gathered to provide the background evidence to ensure the Totnes Plan will meet local needs and where possible its creative aspirations.'
